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Attitude of Parents and Teachers towards Girl Children's Education in Subarnapur District, Odisha, India

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ABSTRACT Girl children's education is an essential part of the education system in India. The development of the nation depends on the rate of the girl children's education. One cannot imagine a developed society without the education of girl children. Awareness of women is necessary to move the country towards progress, prosperity, and a developed nation.
