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Exploring Attitude Towards Science Among Higher Secondary School Science Students

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ABSTRACT Many students choose science because of parental pressure, so this study aims to investigate the attitude of students who have chosen science at the higher secondary level. The investigator constructed an attitude scale with 26 items, standardised using statistical tools. The data was collected from 2,899 students studying in various government and private higher secondary schools in Manipur. The finding shows that students have a positive attitude towards science. The result also shows that even though students have a positive attitude towards science, there is a significant difference in attitude between male and female students. However, no significant difference is found regarding the type of school and the school's location.
