

**Ethnobiological Analysis from Myth to Science XV:
Pancha Yajnya (Five Sacrifices) –
Human Body is an Epicentre of Renunciation**

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ABSTRACT The human body is the epicentre where every individual performs the five great sacrifices (*Yajnya*), each and every moment throughout the life. Activity of the physical body ceases with the death (*Deva Yajnya* and *Bhoota Yajnya*), while his knowledge and perception migrates to the next life (*Rrushi Yajnya*) as *Samskara* (mental impressions). The genetic trait pass on to the next generation (*Pitru Yajnya*) and his social responsibility and humanity gets recorded in history (*Nrru Yajnya*) and makes a person immemorial.
