

Mortality Differentials Among Two Occupationally Different Communities: Yadava and Kamma of Andhra Pradesh

ABSTRACT In the present paper, 667 families of two occupationally different communities, Yadava and Kamma of Krishna and Guntur districts of Andhra Pradesh have been studied. In the populations under study, very few deaths are recorded. For Yadavas, the Crude Death Rate is 6.32 which is higher than the Crude Death Rate of Kammas (2.53). Infant mortality is also found to be lower in both the populations.
