Martial Distance in Manne Dora Tribe of Andhra Pradesh

ABSTRACT The mean martial distance recorded amongst Manne Dora is 15.33 ± 1.08 km. Manne Dora practice high rate of village endogamy (45.97%) and consanguineous marriages (49.90%). Statistically significant differences are observed between the means of consanguineous unions (10.46 \pm 1.60 km) and affinal matings (20.17 \pm 1.76 km). The Manne Dora population shows positively skewed and leptokurtic martial distribution.
