ABSTRACT In the present study genetic traits – ABO and Rh blood groups; morphological traits-chin shape, ear lobe attachment, mid-digital hair; and behavioural traits- hand clasping, arm folding, leg folding among 106 Jat individual of both sexes have been reported. Although various traits differ slightly, when compared, but in general fall in the range of other population groups reported from North India.
