## Distribution of Blood Groups Among Two Kashmiri Population Groups of Jammu and Kashmir, India

**ABSTRACT** To study the genetic constitution of the two Kashmiri population groups - Muslims and Pandits, blood samples collected from Srinagar district were analysed for the  $A_1A_2BO$ , MNSs, Rhesus and Kell blood group systems. There is a similarity in the distribution of these serological markers between the two studied groups.
