## Distribution of Blood Groups Among Gujjars and Three Dogra Population Groups of Jammu District, Jammu and Kashmir, India

ABSTRACT Genetic data on four polymorphic systems, namely A1A,BO, MNSs, Rhesus and Kell, are reported on Gujjars (Scheduled Tribe) and three Dogra population groups - Brahmans, Rajputs and Ramdasias (Scheduled Caste) of Jammu District, Jammu and Kashmir. Distribution of these markers do not show any difference among three Dogra population groups, though Gujjars are little different.
