

Distribution of Red Cell H Substance Among the Muslims of Calcutta

ABSTRACT A total of 285 individuals from Bengalee and Non-Bengalee Sunni Sect Muslim community of Calcutta, West Bengal has been typed for A₁A₂BO blood groups and H substance on the red cells. The distribution and gene frequencies of H substance shows a considerable variability ($p < 0.001$) between these two Muslim communities of Calcutta.
