

**Impact of Deforestation on the Life of the Plain-Bhuiyans
(A Case Study of Two Villages of Northern Orissa)**

ABSTRACT The present paper attempts to understand the changes manifested in the dependence relation of the Plain-Bhuiyans with the forest over a period of thirty years. Two Plain-Bhuiyan villages of Koira block of Sundergarh district were studied for this purpose. It was found out that in the past the Plain-Bhuiyans had constructive dependence on forest that kept a balance between their own needs and environmental imperatives. Industrialization and commercialization of the economic frontier along with the enactment of various legislative measures are responsible for a gradual replacement of this constructive dependence by a destructive dependence.
