## A Study of Morphogenetical Characters Among Selected Population Groups of Jammu and Kashmir, India

ABSTRACT Frequency distribution of three morphogenetical characters, namely, colourblindness, ear lobe attachment and mid-phlangeal hair, among Bodhs, Balis, Dard Muslim (Scheduled tribes) and Tibetans of the Ladakh region, Kashmiri Muslims of the Kashmir region, and Gujjars (Scheduled tribe) and Dogra Caste groups (Brahmans, Rajputs and Ramdasias) of the Jammu region have been presented.
