Changes in Upper Arm Circumference and Fat Fold at Triceps Among Yadava Girls of North Coastal Andhra Pradesh

ABSTRACT A sample of 632 school-going girls of Yadava parentage was studied in a cross-sectional anthropometric survey during January 1986 to June 1987 in Bheemunipatnam and Anandapuram mandals of Visakhapatnam district. In this paper the data on upper arm circumference and skinfold thickness at triceps have been reported. At all age between 1 to 20 years their mean values of arm circumference and fat fold at triceps are observed to be lower than those of the Indian school girls and ICMR standards 1984.
