

## **Data on ABO Group of Binjhvars and Their Phylogenetic Position Among Other Tribal Populations of Madhya Pradesh, India**

**ABSTRACT** Data on ABO blood group system in Binjhwar tribe of Madhya Pradesh, India are presented. Frequencies of Phenotype O, A, B, and AB Blood groups among Binjhvars were 38.22%, 23.15%, 30.82% and 7.81%, respectively and allele A, B and O values are 0.1688, 0.2163 and 0.1649, respectively. The genetic distance analysis revealed that the present tribal population is genetically closer to the Gond, Helba, Bhatra, Bhil and Bhilala tribes inhabiting this Central Indian state.
