Finger Dermatoglyphic Variation Among the Yanadis A Tribe from Andhra Pradesh, India

ABSTRACT A sample of 230 Yanadis (115 males and 115 females) from Yerpedu Mandal, Chittor District Andhra Pradesh were studied for qualitative and quantitative finger dermatoglyphic characters. Among qualitative and quantitative characters, bisexual differences have been observed but statisitically these are non-significant.
