

**Anthropo-Demographic Study among the Caste and Tribal
Group of Central Himalayas: 3. Mortality Differentials and
Determinants**

ABSTRACT Mortality measures and determinants have been presented for the caste groups of Kumaun and the Bhotia tribal groups from Uttar Pradesh Hills or Uttarakhand. The various population groups reveal differential mortality particularly infant, child and under-five mortality which are indicators of the groups environments and development. The major socio-cultural determinants found to influence child survival are education levels of the father and mother, income of the household and occupation.
