

Metric Evaluation of Axial Triradius of Palm

ABSTRACT The axial triradius is usually present in the proximal part of the palm in alignment to the fourth metacarpal bone. Sometimes there may be two or three and rarely none. Accordingly starting from the proximal part of the palm, they are referred to as proximal (t), intermediate (t) and distal (t) and when absent (O). However these terms are qualitative and lack precision. The present paper proposes the logical method for the quantitative evaluation of the positions of the axial triradii.
