Dentition State of the Slav – Avar Population of Šebastovce (Eastern Slovakia)

ABSTRACT The state of the dentition was evaluated in 141 adult individuals from Slav – Avar burial ground at Šebastovce (Eastern Slovakia). Caries frequency, that is, the percentage of individuals affected by dental decay, was 91.49 percent. Caries intensity, that is, the percentage of teeth affected by dental decay, reaches 26.94 percent. Caries rate in the population of Šebastovce is higher than in other Slav and Early – Medieval population living on our territory.
