Adolescents Sexual Behavioural Response to HIV/AIDS Education

ABSTRACT This study examined the sexual behavioural changes in adolescents following HIV/AIDS education. It was a quasi experimental research guided by four research questions: The sample of the study consisted of 47 in school adolescents from Illeh Secondary School (experimental) and Uhiele Secondary school (control). The pre and post test instrument was a questionnaire duly validated and found reliable. The pre-test results showed that the control group seemed to practice better sexual behaviour than the experimental group. While the post test result showed the experimental group got better than the control group in the practice of correct sexual behaviour. This indicated positive outcome from the intervention which should be sustained and extended to other groups.
