ABSTRACT Cancer is the abnormal proliferation of cells, which accumulate and form tumors that may compress, invade and destroy normal tissue. In breast cancer, the malignant cells are found in the tissues of the breast. The hereditary breast cancer results from the mutations of BRCA 1 and BRCA 2 genes.
