ABSTRACT In the study, the General Screening Model, which is one of the descriptive methods has been used. Validity and reliability studies of the 19-item Lifelong Learning Attitude Scale used in the study were conducted and the Cronbach's Alpha internal reliability coefficient was calculated as 0.94.
